I have also met George's wife and other family members many times, and now I can do nothing more than share their sorrow and extend my sincere condolences. It will not be easy to come over this loss, but life must go on for the best of everybody.

Finally I am sure that thousands and thousands of sport friends and martial arts students all over the world will join me in my wish, that George's work will be carried forward and never forgotten. Let us all hope that the knowledge and wisdom George has spread over the entire martial arts world will be to the benefit of mankind and give coming generations further visions, what sport really can bring, such as peace, happiness and decent lives!
