1. <u>Shotokan Karate - Mr. Randy Sanders</u> (7th Dan Karate; 4th Dan Goju Ryu; 4th Dan Okinawan Kobudo, 4th Dan Iai Jujutsu, ITMA) is owner and Chief Instructor of NM Shotokan Karate. With Dianne Peterson, Technical Director of New Mexico Shotokan Karate. She holds a 6th Dan in Karate (ITMA)

2. <u>Traditional Jujutsu - Dr. Andrew Yiannakis</u> (8th Dan Jujutsu; 6th Dan Judo. UNM and Director of ITMA). Dr. Yiannakis has been teaching judo and jujutsu for almost 50 years and is the National Chair of the Traditional Jujutsu Committee of the USJJF. He teaches Jujutsu at UNM and Sandia Budokan (in Albuquerque). He is also a certified Handgun Disarming Instructor. He is also the author of "*JUJUTSU: Traditions, Ways & Modern Practices*", which is soon to be released on Amazon

3. <u>MMA/Personal Defense-Mr. Josh Ortega-Scheiner</u> (7th Dan, Kenpo). Mr. Scheiner has been teaching the Seidler System of Personal Defense at UNM since 1993. He is a retired Fire Dept. Mr. Watkins specializes in Aikido open hands and weapons techniques (Bokken & Jo). Sensei is a part time instructor in the HESS Dept. at UNM where he teaches both weapons and Taijutsu (open hands). He also teaches two free Women's Self Defense Clinics thru the UNM Rec Services Dept. which is open to all staff and students of the UNM community.
